- (ii) The Senate considered the recommendations of Chairman, SDPC regarding the termination of Ms. Ritu Kumari (2017RME12) Mechanical Engineering Doctoral Programme, owing to absence without sanctioned leave. The Senate resolved to terminate her from the programme as per clause 5.3 of Doctoral Ordinances.
- (iii) The Senate deliberated on the recommendations of SDPC for improvement of the quality of Ph.D. work at the Institute, that there shall be "at least two accepted/published papers in SSCI/SCI/Scopus indexed publications/ patent (approved / granted) as one of the criteria" for submission of thesis. 

Following are the resolutions of the Committee:

- 1) With reference to the letter Ref. No. 17/SNFCE/2018 dated April 12, 2018 from Faculty-in-Charge, School of Non Formal and Continuing Education (SNFCE), regarding the admission of M.Tech. (Part-time) programmes of the Institute, Committee took the cognizance of the fact, that since last three academic sessions (2015-16, 2016-17 & 2017-18), there is zero admission to these programmes of the Institute. This has the adverse impact on our commitment to society.
 - Currently the admissions to these programmes are based on only Written Test (covering the entire domain of respective UG programme).
 - Minimum 08 numbers of candidates are required to run a programme.
 - Candidate willing to take admission in these programmes should have minimum 02 years of working experience after the qualifying degree.

It has also been observed that for more experienced candidates having expertise in particular domain, getting admission based on only Written Examination becomes challenging.

Therefore, Committee felt that along with Written Examination there is need for considering the Academic Credentials, Work Experience and Personal Interaction with candidates as the basis for admission to these programmes. Committee discussed the proposal of Faculty-in-Charge, SNFCE. After long deliberations the Committee proposes that the admission in M.Tech. (Parttime) programmes of the Institute should be based on following 04 components:

Minutes of the Meeting

A meeting of the Committee constituted by the Senate in its Sixtieth (60(h) meeting to submit recommendation related to the proposal on "Academic Consultancy and to revive and strengthen the Part-time M. Tech, and PhD courses" was held on May 10, 2018 at 5:30 pm in the Office of the Head, School of Management Studies

Following members of the Committee were present in the meeting

The committee deliberated on the proposal presented to the Senate (60th meeting) by the Dean (RGIA) and the in principal agreement of the Senate on the proposal. The recommendation is to revive the Part-time M. Tech. PhD courses and in the process it is proposed to start running specialized subjects in the evening for eligible candidates including working professionals (See Ameeure A)

The minutes of the meeting are as under:

1. The Committee proposed following modalities for running the specialized subjects in the evening by various departments under the umbrella of SNFCE, these modalities include the points recommended in the proposal document (Annexure A):

A. Programme Detail and Admission

- i) The Programme may be named as "Executive Development Programme (EDP)"
- ii) Admission may be done on the basis of one or combination of following methodsinterview, points on academic qualifications, and points on work experience to be decided and conducted by the Departmental Masters Selection Committee (DMSC).
- iii) Number of registration in each Subject: Minimum 10, Maximum 30
- iv) The eligibility criteria for admission may be same as the eligibility criteria specified for admission to the Masters Programme(s) of the Department.
- v) For Interdisciplinary and Contemporary EDP subjects, the syllabus and eligibility criteria for admission shall be proposed by the faculty offering the subject and with recommendation of the DMPC the proposal shall be communicated to Dean Academic for necessary approval by competent authority.
- vi) Fee amount to be charged for one subject may be Rs. 10,000/-
- vii) Classes per week: 4 hour (two slots of two class hour each on two working days in evening)
- viii) For Summer Semester, the classes per week: 10 (five slots of two class hours each on five days of the week in evening).

B. Evaluation and Grading

- i) First exam (Mid Term) after 20 classes and Final exam (End Term) after 40 classes to be aligned with the Institute Examination Schedule.
- ii) A minimum of 75% attendance shall be mandatory. Otherwise no certificate and Mark-sheet will be issued to the candidate.
- iii) Examination and Grading System of MNNIT Allahabad will be followed for certificates and Mark-sheet.

C. Faculty Responsibility and Benefits

i) One Faculty may be permitted to offer only one subject in a semester.

 Faculty member offering a course shall take the responsibility of advertising the EDP and attract good candidates.

iii) Remuneration amount for faculty member offering one subject shall be Rs. 40,000/- for lectures (around 40 lectures), and Rs. 5000/- for conducting each examination.

iv) Total amount of registration fee shall be treated as Academic Consultancy of the faculty member.

v) Two or more faculty member may jointly offer one subject, in such cases the amount mentioned in point number iii) and iv) above shall be distributed among them.

D. Role of the Department

i) All the Academic Departments of the Institute may be permitted to offer EDP courses under this scheme.

ii) Under this EDP scheme, the Department can list subjects to offer along with the name of the faculty from its pool of the subjects offered in the Master Programs of the Department.

iii) In addition to the pool of subjects, the Department may propose to offer contemporary subjects in its discipline. In such cases the subject with content needs to be recommended by the DMPC and be communicated to the Dean Academic for necessary approval by the competent authority.

iv) The announcement can appear on Institute Website in the month of May for odd semester, month of October for even semester and month of March for Summer Semester, for the benefit of prospective candidates.

E. General Guideline

The progress may be reviewed by the Senate or a Committee Constituted by the Senate after two years from the start of the Executive Development Programme.

ii) The candidates who accumulate 10 such subjects with grades of C or above in the last three years can register for two years part-time M. Tech. program, which would have only thesis work as the remaining requirement.

iii) The graduate candidates who accumulate 10 such subjects with grades of C or above in the last three years can register for part-time PhD program which would have only thesis work (including Comprehensive Exam, State of the Art Seminar) as the remaining requirement.

iv) The candidates who are already M. Tech., and have accumulated 5 such subjects with grades of C or above in the last two years can register for part-time PhD program which would have only thesis work (including comprehensive exam, state of- the-art seminar) as the remaining requirement.

v) Inter-Departmental credit transfer may be permitted subject to the approval by the Department in case of above point number ii), iii) and iv).

- 2. The members of the committee deliberated on the revival of **Part-Time M. Tech.** courses being offered under the umbrella of SNFCE and resolved the following:
 - a. Considering the past admission data and the analysis of the reasons for poor admission in these programmes, it is recommended that admission to part-time programme be done on the basis of Written Test, Interview, Points on Academic Qualifications, and Points on Work Experience with equal weightage each four criterion (proposed distribution of points is annexed as Annexure B).
 - b. Considering the proposal of Head, SMS for starting "Executive MBA" programme; it is resolved that the Executive MBA programme may be started with a total maximum intake of 30 students, Modalities for admission may remain same as proposed at point number 2(a) above. All other modalities such as fee structure, seat matrix may remain

- c. Option of starting other Masters courses such as part-time MSC, part-time MCA may also be permitted, in case the respective Department wishes so.
- 3. Similar to the deliberations on Part-Time M. Tech. programme, the committee is also of the opinion that Part-Time Ph. D. programme may be started again for the benefit of the society.
