This newly instituted sponsored scholarship shall be named as "**G. K. Agrawal and Padmavati**" and will be given to the students of B.Tech. (Civil




Engineering) and B.Tech. (Mechanical Engineering).

After the detailed discussions on the recommendations of DMPC of HSS Department, the Committee resolved that the department may collect some more strong facts (including ongoing MSW program in Prayagraj and its proximity) in support of their recommendation for the re-starting of MSW program.
5. The Committee considered the recommendations of DMPC of the following Departments (ECED dated 05/07/2019, MED dated 10/07/2019, Applied Mechanics dated 26/07/2019 and 05/08/2019, and EED dated 08/08/2019) regarding attending the industrial internship for 11 Months/One Year after M.Tech. 2nd Semester coordinated by the Training and Placement section of the Institute. In view of recommendation of DMPC of the above said Departments, the committee resolves to recommend for joining the industrial internship of the following students of the respective departments as shown in Table. Further, the students are required to complete the registration, presentation/evaluation of End Semester Examination(s) and other academic requirements pertaining to their Thesis work with the consultation of their supervisors as per academic calendar (session 2019 -20) parallel to the Industrial Internship. The case is referred to Senate for the grant of special permission to join the internship for 11 Months/One Year after M.Tech. 2nd semester for the session 2019 -20.
