The Building and Works Committee while considering the status of ongoing works presented by the CPWD Allahabad observed the following:

(i) The progress of all the works undertaken by CPWD is very slow and is not as per the time schedule given by CPWD earlier.

The Building and Works Committee noted the extension period as informed by the CPWD as per column (6) of the above table for completion of ongoing project works.

Further, the Building and Works Committee desired that the representatives of the CPWD may be informed that the delay in projects will be attributable to the contractor and the Institute will consider escalation only for the justified period. The Institute will not consider any escalation for period, other than that what has not been considered, as justified.

The Building and Works Committee also desired that the CPWD may be asked to provide to the Institute the delay report from the start of the work to till date and CPWD may also be asked to provide the revised CPM Chart to the Institute.

The Building and Works Committee, furthermore, desired that the CPWD and the Institute Engineers shall ensure that there is no change in the AA & ES of the work. Also, they may be advised that in all future work, all the scope of works may be included in PE itself and no changes in PE will be allowed.

The Building and Works Committee also observed and noted the following in respect of ongoing projects of the CPWD:

(a) Construction of Boys Hostel:

- (i) The Building and Works Committee noted the revised completion date of the project as proposed by the CPWD is 28.02.2022 and the furniture & kitchen accessories work will be completed by June, 2022.
- (ii) The Building and Works Committee noted the observations of Dean (P&D) that there are major cracks in tiles at some places. The Building and Works Committee directed that CPWD may be asked to replace the same.



(b) Construction of Multi-Storied Faculty Quarters (G+12):

- (i) The Building and Works Committee noted that the CPWD has changed the date of completion of Project from 29.11.2021 to 18.06.2022.
- (ii) As informed by the CPWD the delay in the project as on date is of six [6] months and the current progress is 50%. Representatives of CPWD assured that the balance progress of 50% work will be completed by 18.06.2022.

(c) <u>Widening and Re-carpeting of road with provision of interlocking tiles</u> on road berms in Academic, Residential and Hostel Campus of the Institute:

The Building and Works Committee noted that 95% of the said work has been completed. The Building and Works Committee has been apprised by the Dean (P&D) that the re-carpeted road is not properly leveled.

Considering above, the Building and Works Committee resolved that the CPWD should rectify the observations pointed by Dean (P&D) and will properly level the road before completion.

The Building and Works Committee resolved that the presentation given by the CPWD may be taken on record.

Item No. 36.04

To consider the report of Fifth [5th] meeting of the Project Monitoring Group [PMG] held on 01.10.2021 of the Institute.

Item No. 36.05

: To consider the matter of empanelment of contractors for Civil and Electrical Works in the Institute.

Resolution

: The Building and Works Committee considered the matter of empanelment of contractors for Civil & Electrical Works in the Institute.

The Building and Works Committee was apprised that the Building and Works Committee in its Thirty second [32nd] meeting held on 30.10.2019 vide resolution No. 32.03 has resolved that the institute may register/ empanel contractors already registered with CPWD but not blacklisted / debarred by CPWD. Accordingly, the Institute has advertised and invited applications for empanelment of contractor for executing additions / alterations / modifications etc. of Civil and Electrical works in the existing buildings and execution of original / minor works with an estimated cost of upto ₹ 5.00 Lakhs through limited tenders as per the provisions of Rule 139 (v) GFR – 2017.

The Building and Works Committee considering the recommendations of the Committee constituted for evaluating of the applications submitted by the applicants for empanelment of contractors for Civil and Electrical Works in the Institute, resolved to approve the same.
